

## **MUNICIPALITY OF DANIEL UTAH**

### **ANNEXATION POLICY PLAN**

**ENACTED OCTOBER 2, 2006**

In accordance with the provisions of 10-2-401.5, Utah Code Annotated, the Town of Daniel hereby adopts the following criteria for consideration of possible future annexations. This annexation policy plan is intended to incorporate all the criteria required and suggested by sections 10-2-401.5 Utah Code Annotated.

This document, together with the attached annexation map (see Attachment B), shall constitute the official annexation policy plan for the Town Of Daniel.

Daniel Town is a rural community that has experienced growth-pressure due to the proximity to the Wasatch Front. The current Town limits are unique in many ways. The surrounding area contains wet lands, hillsides, animal habitat, ridgelines and streams, as well as aquifers that supply domestic and irrigation water to residents of the Town. The original boundaries were set by a committee organized by the Wasatch County Council in 2006.

The Town does not own the water system that serves the residents. The Town planning commission and the Town Council have stated that the protection of water resources is a high priority for the Town and its residents.

The Planning Commission and the Town Council have decided to allow and encourage the annexation of property now in unincorporated Wasatch County that is contiguous (see attached map) to the Town and welcome all to apply.

The area on the attached annexation map includes "traditional" Daniel as it is known to the local residents. Local control over zoning is a priority to the Town. The current town boundaries include a small commercial zone on Highway 40 and industrial zone surrounding the Airport area; most of the other areas in the town are zoned RA-5.

The Town officials understand the need for municipal services in the undeveloped areas of the proposed annexation areas. The Town is willing to provide services in any area annexed as currently provided for Daniel Town residents. These services could possibly be financed through taxes, grants, impact fees or exactions, etc. Based on the cost of current services the Town officials do not expect any negative impacts on the Town of Daniel on any area proposed for annexation.

All annexation petitions filed with the town shall provide all the information required by Section 10-2-403 of the Utah Code Annotated.
